Public Health Announcement Regarding Upcoming Spring Street Fair, April 25 & 26

Encinitas 101 MainStreet Association is working with the City of Encinitas to closely monitor the emergence and spread of the Coronavirus and will be taking steps to provide the public and vendors information on how to mitigate the risk of exposure.

Public health officials advise washing hands with soap and water, avoid touching your face, staying home when sick with Coronavirus like symptoms and avoid contact with people who are sick. The City of Encinitas has released a press release that they will be coordinating with the San Diego County on any infectious disease response plan and will continue to closely monitor the Coronavirus situation.

E101 will be following the California Department of Public Health's current recommendations to not cancel upcoming public events. The Encinitas Spring Street Fair is will be going forward as planned on April 25-26.
